

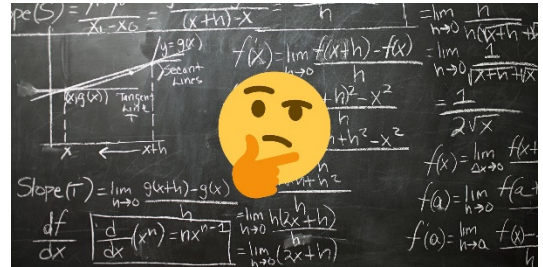

Reporting COVID Related Separations in CaseBuilder

The pandemic is still affecting employers in different ways. Below are related codes members might select in CaseBuilder if you are notified about a claim.

Lack of Work Due to COVID

Separation Reason	
Select a category that best fits the claimant's reason for separation or employment status:	Lack of Work ▼
Based on -Lack of Work- What best fits the claimant's reason for separation or employment status:	Due to National Tragedy. ▼

Fraudulent Cases

Separation Reason	
Select a category that best fits the claimant's reason for separation or employment status:	Still Working ▼
Based on -Still Working- What best fits the claimant's reason for separation or employment status:	Employee did not file claim. ▼

Discharge for Refusal to Vaccinate

Separation Reason	
Select a category that best fits the claimant's reason for separation or employment status:	Involuntary ▼
Based on -Involuntary- What best fits the claimant's reason for separation or employment status:	Rule Violation ▼
Based on -Rule Violation- What best fits the claimant's reason for separation or employment status:	Discharged for COVID Vaccine Refusal ▼
